### What is Chalk on the Walk?

Chalk on the Walk is the Cambridge version of an Italian street painting festival and the Cambridge Rotary Club's Annual Fundraiser. Due to COVID-19 it will be held as virtual event celebration.





### What can I expect from this event?

The large crowd (upwards of 100,000 people!) provides great name exposure for the sponsors and arfists-many of whom return year aCer year-- and excellent public present for Rotary. Arfists receive some supplies.





### How does it work?

Artists are paired with local businesses and individuals who are sponsors. Artists are recruited from a regional area and compete for prize money/ gift certificates that totaled over \$1,250 at last year's event.

### What does the event support?

Proceeds help the Cambridge Rotary Club support college scholarships, local literacy and education programs and many Cambridge service organizations and projects.
